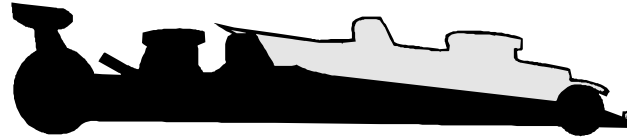

MAASS, FIELLO EARN SUPER COMP VICTORIES AT LACR

Eric Maass and Jon Fiello earned Southern California Super Comp Assoc. victories at Los Angeles County Raceway on a series doubleheader midway through the 2000 schedule.

Maass had a big weekend, as he not only won the fourth race on the schedule; he qualified first for race, and ended up winning the Sunday consolation race.

In the semifinal of the Saturday race, Maass cut a .401 light and ran 9.111, 149 (9.12 index) to defeat Robert Miller's 'Frank Hawley Drag Racing School' entry with a 9.103, 159.52 (.436 light), while Kain Gallagher went to the final with a 9.08, 155.99 (.422 r.t.) as Chris McNicol drew a red-light (.383) and lost with a 9.11, 150.98.

In the final round, Maass took the win with a 9.100, 156.50 (.427 r.t.) as Gallagher got bit by the red-bulb, a .389, and 9.10, 156.05. Eric would like to thank C.L. Bryant Fuels, Pennzoil, PermaCool, ATO Transmissions, Continental Converters, and Performance Industries for their efforts with his race car. He gives special thanks to his wife Teri, and crew Matt Allen and Beth Olson.

Twenty year-old Jonathan Fiello won his first Super Comp race during the Sunday afternoon contest, the fifth points race of the season, when he beat Val Torres Sr in the final. Semifinal action saw Fiello run a 9.139, 157.00 (.422 r.t.) to beat Spanky James, losing with a 9.143, 153.83 (.428 r.t.) and Torres ran a 9.114, 156.78 (.453 r.t.) to go to the final as Chris Diyco's Frank & Son Card Show-sponsored dragster lost with a .399 red-light and 9.161, 157.35.

In the final, Fiello got the win as Torres draw a .391 red light. Fiello ran a 9.126, 157.27 with his Undercover Chassis dragster, while Torres settled for runner-up with a 9.138, 151.70.

Consolation race winners included Chris Diyco on Saturday, as he beat Mike Solina, and Eric Maass stopped Charlie Waggoner in Sunday's second-chance final.

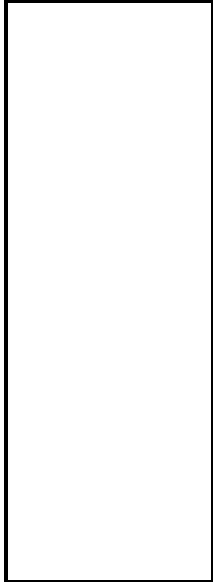
